

# Keynote Speaker Milton Carter Davis

A Tuskegee, Alabama, native and Tuskegee University alumnus, Milton C. Davis has enjoyed a legal career spanning service in the military, public and private sectors.

After completing a bachelor's degree in political science at Tuskegee in 1971, Davis earned his Juris Doctor degree from University of Iowa's College of Law in 1974. During his collegiate years, he earned distinction as an American Political Science Foundation graduate fellow, a Ford

Foundation graduate fellow, a Herbert Lehman Foundation International Scholar and a Distinguished Air Force ROTC graduate. During his law school studies, he excelled in oral advocacy and was named to the Senior Moot Court Board.

Davis' career achievements include being among the first African-Americans in Alabama to be appointed a state assistant attorney general. He received nationwide acclaim for his role in securing the full pardon for Clarence Norris, the last known surviving "Scottsboro Boy" on the basis of innocence. In 1977, Davis returned to Tuskegee to begin his private legal practice. His career highlights also include 25 years of service in the U.S. Air Force Reserves Judge Advocate General Corps through which he ultimately attained the rank of lieutenant colonel, as well as teaching business courses as an adjunct professor at Tuskegee University's College of Business.

Outside his professional responsibilities, Davis served for eight years as a member of the Alabama State Board of Bar Examiners, in addition to serving on numerous committees of the Alabama State Bar Association and as president of the Macon County Bar Association. He is a life fellow of the Alabama Law Foundation, a member of the Lawyers' Advisory Committee for the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Alabama, and a former member of the Lawyers' Advisory Committee for the U.S. Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals.

Currently, Davis serves on the board of directors of the Central Alabama Community Foundation, which oversees the distribution of millions of dollars to charitable and nonprofit organizations throughout southeast Alabama. He is a former board member of Leadership Alabama, a distinguished network of Alabama leaders, and a board member for and vice president of the Lionel Richie

# **Milton Carter Davis**

Foundation Inc. Davis is a member of Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity, also known as the Boulé. He is an active member of Resurrection Catholic Church in Montgomery, Alabama.

For four years, Davis served as the 29th General President of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity — the first African-American collegiate fraternity, which was founded at Cornell University in 1906. During his term as President, the U.S. Congress passed legislation and President Bill Clinton signed into law the bill authorizing Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity the exclusive right to construct the Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial on the National Mall in Washington, D.C.

Davis' numerous accolades include being honored by Black Enterprise Magazine as the recipient of its National Achievement Award for his contributions to criminal justice. He also was recognized by Ebony and Jet magazines as one of their "50 Leaders of the Future." From 1993 through 1996, Davis appeared among Ebony magazine's list of "100 Most Influential African-Americans." He also is listed in Who's Who in Alabama.

Davis is married to Dr. Myrtle E. Goore, a practicing physician in Montgomery, where the couple reside. They are the parents of two adult sons and have two grandchildren.

Reverend Dr. Benjamin N. Thomas Sr. was raised and educated in Kansas City, Missouri. Reverend Thomas entered into the United States Army in 1970 and was commissioned as an officer in 1980, serving as Chaplain in the Army Reserves until 1993. He has special training in clinical pastoral counseling, patient visitation, crisis intervention, and church administration. He is the current pastor of Historic Tanner Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Church, Phoenix, AZ, since 1991. Reverend Thomas is a dedicated family man, married to Beverly K. Thomas.

They have one child, Rev. Benjamin Jr., "Rev. BJ," who is a graduate of Southern University in Baton Rouge, LA., and is currently serving as the pastor of Bethel A.M.E. Church in Oxnard, CA. Rev. & Mrs. Thomas also have three grandchildren, Samara Jean, Benjamin Nathaniel III, and Bryson Jerome.

#### Education

Reverend Thomas earned his Associate's degree in Psychology from Penn Valley Community College in Kansas City, MO., and his Bachelor's degree in Business Administration with a minor in Psychology from Parks College, Parksville, MO.

Reverend Thomas began his theological studies at Claremont School of Theology in Claremont, CA., in their DMIN program. He later transferred to Asbury Theological Seminary in Kentucky and completed three years of study through the Beeson Institute for Advanced Church Leadership.

Reverend Thomas received an honorary Doctorate degree from Southern California School of Ministry in Los Angeles, CA.

#### **Ministerial Experience**

Prior to moving to Phoenix, Arizona in 1991, to become the pastor of Tanner Chapel African Methodist Episcopal (A.M.E.) Church, Reverend Thomas served as the pastor of Price Chapel A.M.E. Church in Los Angeles, CA., Walker Chapel A.M.E. Church in Seattle, WA., and Handy Chapel A.M.E. Church in Joplin, MO. Currently, Reverend Thomas is serving as the Senior Minister and Pastor for Historic Tanner Chapel A.M.E. Church, Phoenix, AZ.

During his six (6) years pastoring at Price Chapel A.M.E. Church, Reverend Thomas was actively involved in the community serving on the Board of Directors for such organizations as Emergency Feeding Program, The

# The Award of Merit Roy M. Tatem, Jr.

Roy M. Tatem Jr. is a renowned community leader, political activist, and entrepreneur originally hailing from Virginia Beach, Virginia. In January 1999, Roy landed a coveted job on Capitol Hill as a staffer for Senator Chuck Robb (D-VA), working in constituent services and assisting Virginia residents in their concerns about proposed policy and legislation impacting our nation. Roy worked on key issues pertinent to the Senator's priorities for Virginia and his constituents, such as public safety, gun control, women's rights, education, and veterans affairs.

#### A Talented Businessman

At the same time, Roy pursued a business opportunity with LegalShield, which provides legal service plans and identity theft services. With LegalShield, Roy was recognized in 2005 as one of the youngest Executives to achieve the coveted six-figure ring, which simply means that his personal and team sales earned him over \$100,000.00 in commissions in a 12-month time frame. This unique chance furnished him with the means and the freedom to become active and productive in his community by working as a community organizer.

#### **Community Organizing Extraordinaire**

Roy began his community organizing journey as a college student in 1996. He made it his mission to work on political campaigns that would have the greatest impact on his community. He became a sensation in local races and captured the attention of several presidential candidates, serving as the Grassroots Coordinator for Hampton Roads for Barack Obama in 2008 and as the Deputy Director for African American Outreach for Bernie Sanders in 2016.

Today, Roy is the principal of Vanguard Strategies and Consulting, LLC, which he established in 2016. His firm provides strategic marketing and campaign solutions to political candidates, social movements, and businesses. Vanguard's clients range from elected officials and those aspiring to become elected officials to socially conscious organizations and media groups working to educate and engage the community around a specific issue.

Roy also served as the president of the East Valley NAACP from 2016-2020; Roy's political success and experience have allowed him to serve as a national delegate to the Democratic National Convention and was the former Senior Political Director for Our Voice, Our Vote Arizona.

Roy has held many professional political positions and appointments that are as diverse as they are impressive. He served as Special Advisor to the Mayor and City Council in Tempe, AZ. He serves on Colonel Jeff Glover's Advisory Council to the Arizona Department of Public Safety and Sheriff Penzone's African American Advisory Committee. Roy is a respected member of the City of Tempe African American Advisory Committee and is a former Commissioner on Tempe's Census Complete Count Committee. Roy is a lifelong member of the National Urban League and received recognition as one of the Top 10 Young Professional Leaders at their 2017 national convention. In 2019, Roy was accepted into the Race, Equity, and Leadership in Schools Institute at Harvard Graduate School of Education.

#### An Accomplished Graduate

Roy is a proud 1998 graduate of the historic Virginia State University, completing a degree in Political Science with a minor in Philosophy. In 2021, Roy completed his graduate studies at Arizona State University, earning his Master's Degree in Integrated Social Sciences, where he concentrated his studies on public safety and social services; his Master's Thesis was entitled: Social Work Policing: An embedded autonomous model.

He resides in Chandler, Arizona, with his wife, Keisha, his nieces, Tamia, Bryanna, and Jordan, and the amazing memory of his daughter Madison (deceased).

















